For the loading of butyric acids and heptanoic acid, the following applies:

If the outlet of tanker trucks is angled downward, it must have a minimum height of 65 cm above the ground (lower edge). If the outlet is straight (perpendicular to the ground), there is no minimum height requirement.

Tank trucks and tank containers must be equipped with a top-connectable vapor recovery system, which must be located in the middle to rear section of the tank.

Multi-compartment vehicles are not accepted.

Requirements for all vehicles:

secured access (safety railing/walkway; on both sides, but at least on one side) - vehicles without a safety railing may be rejected.

Tank containers are only approved for loading if they are flush with the rear of the chassis or if the chassis allows access to the bottom outlets.

For safety reasons, drivers must be able to communicate safely in German or English, otherwise access to the plant may be denied.

At the loading station, drivers are generally required to carry personal protective equipment (full-body covering clothing, safety shoes according to EN 345, safety helmet, safety goggles).

Attention - Legal requirement for winter tires!

During Cold season, the plant may only be entered with winter tires. Controls are carried out from Nov. 1st to March 15th and it may lead to rejections in case of non-compliance, regardless of weather conditions.

Due to the tightening of the EU sanctions package against Russia, we do not accept vehicles with Russian or Belarusian licence plates. We are obliged to refuse loading / transport immediately. Forwarders, whose company is more than 25% owned by Russia are excluded.

Please note that we don't apply to ADR 1.1.3.6 – "1000-Punkte-Regelung".

Important information regarding required loading times at all OXEA loading locations

Unless otherwise agreed, all OXEA loading locations require the following free loading times:

3 hours for regular loads (one product, one compartment vehicle)

5 hours for multi-compartment vehicles loading more than one product

3 hours per loading location for multi-compartment vehicles loading in different loading locations (e.g. loading one product in Oberhausen and one product in Marl)

For additional waiting time caused by OXEA we will reimburse up to € 50,- per hour against a valid proof. Waiting time occurred due to lack of timeslot booking won't be reimbursed.
